Health Routine Protocols:

Protocols are subject to change based on CDC guidelines

- Staff and children will be screened upon arrival with temperature check and will complete a health questionnaire daily
- A back to school packet will be sent shortly and must be submitted before the beginning of the school year. More information to follow
- We have adjusted the baseline temperature to 100 (in order to avoid false positives).
- Teachers will wear masks throughout the entire day.
- A nurse will available during school hours
- Students must wear masks.
- Parents must remain in car during carpool arrival and pick up. No entry to school buildings.
- A Staff member will be assigned specifically to your child's classroom will walk them in.
- Maximum capacity per classroom is 15 students.
- Classes may be combined based on number of students by grade level.
- Specialists will come into classroom.
- Co-mingling of classes may be considered outdoors or in indoors spaces if social distance can be honored.

General Cleaning Protocols

- Upon arrival to classroom: Routine handwashing, additional handwashing stations outside of classrooms.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned daily.
- Air filters will be checked monthly and changed as needed.
- Teachers will wipe down surfaces throughout the day with cleaning supplies provided by the school.

Snacks and supplies

- Students will receive school supplies, text book, and notebook. (if applicable- needed supplies will be packed individually)
- Ipads will be disinfected after each session.
- Snacks will be distributed individually upon arrival to the classroom. (outdoors area)
- We are kindly asking parents not to send any snacks unless there is a severe allergic case.
- Water fountains will not be in use.

Field trips

- Will be offered based on CDC guidelines.

Special workshops

- Special workshops such as Shofar Factory or other third party vendors will be offered based on CDC guidelines.

Family engagement opportunities

- Will be offered based on CDC guidelines.

Classroom Instruction

- Classes will be offered K-6
- Groups may be combined based on enrollment per grade level.
- Google classroom practice will be available, and submission of assignment will be reinforced to be posted.
- If applicable, families will receive a communication indicating the Zoom ID for each group for the year
- If applicable, Zoom etiquette must be honored during instruction.
- A code of contact must be submitted to the school office prior to the beginning of the school year.
- Family engagement opportunities will be offered throughout the year online or in person if permitted by CDC guidelines.
