A selection from Psalms or other passages found elsewhere in this book may be read. There is no special prayer or benediction to be recited. It is appropriate to meditate briefly, silently or aloud. Some suggested reflections follow.

 I now recall my dear \_\_\_\_\_ who has gone to his/her eternal home. May his/her soul be bound up in the bond of life, in peace. Amen.

 I kindle this light in loving memory of \_\_\_\_\_, recalling words from the Book of Proverbs: "The soul of man is the light of the Lord."

 *Zekher tzadik livrakhah.* The memory of the righteous is a blessing. May my life continue to embrace the life and deeds, the words and thoughts of \_\_\_\_\_ who has gone to his/her eternal home. May he/she rest in peace. Amen.

 O merciful God, I turn to You in prayer on the *yahrzeit* of the death of my dear \_\_\_\_\_. Be with me as I stand in remembrance and in loving recollection. As I light this candle in his/her memory, I put my trust in You.

 Renew my strength, O Lord. I am grateful for the years of the life of \_\_\_\_\_. Help me to understand how my life has been formed and shaped by what he/she was and by what he/she did. Help me to make part of my life a living monument of holiness to his/her memory. May he/she rest in peace. Amen.

## A RELIGION OF LIFE

## A RESPONSE AND A WITNESS

If the death of someone close to us brings us to explore the limits of our capacities for strength, love, and cheerfulness, if it leads us to discover sources of consolation which we never knew before, then we make our departed into a witness for the affirmation of life rather than its rejection.

There is one thing which we can still do for those whom we have loved and lost. We could not keep them alive. Perhaps we could not even lessen their pain significantly. But now, after their death, we can let them be witnesses for God and for life.

The dead depend on us for their redemption and their immortality.

## A Yizkor Message

There is a Yiddish expression – “Going backwards is still a kind of travel”. Like many Yiddish maxims it is filled with wisdom. Think of some of the expressions in English which are so prevalent today: 1) Move on; 2) Get over it; 3) Keep moving forward; 4) You can't go home. It is not an accident that American students have the worse understanding of history of any western nation. It's because we don't like to look backwards. We want to be forward looking. What we forget is that the best way to go forward is to understand where you came from. The best way to know which direction to go in is to know which direction you came from. That is part of what Yizkor is all about. We do want to “keep moving forward” but not before we first travel backwards in time. We recite Yizkor at the end of each of our major Holiday seasons: High Holy Days culminating on Yom Kippur, Sukkot culminating on Shemeni Atzeret, Pesach and Shavuot. We do it as the Holidays end and then we move on to the next season. We first travel backwards and remember those who helped mold and fashion who we are today.

Isaac Bashevis Singer once wrote: “When a person who was close to you dies, in the first few weeks after that person's death, he/she is as far from you, as far as a near person can ever be – only with the years does he/she become nearer, and then you can almost live with the person.” Yizkor helps us accomplish that goal – allowing our loved ones who are gone to still live with us – to be nearer to us each year that passes rather than to have them be more distant because of the passage of time. Our conversations with our late parents grow more frequent as the time passes since their deaths. (They are not one sided since we always know what their response would have been.) As Rabbi Morris Adler once wrote – “Her presence is more vital to me than her absence”.

We are a people who sanctify time. We are also time travelers. We live in the present and the past at the same time and use that skill to build our future. Rabbi Akiba is still our teacher 2000 years later and our parents, spouses, siblings, children and friends who might be gone are still present in our lives no matter how many years have passed. People who say Yizkor find it possible to speak of their departed loved ones as if they were still part of their lives. That doesn't surprise me because they still are. That is the power of memory – the power of Yizkor. Praised are You O Lord our God Who enables us to remember.

Our appreciation to Marcia Frantz who organizes this Book of Remembrance each and every year as an act of love and because she understands how important it is to all of us. And thank you to all those who have made this Book Of Remembrance possible by looking backwards before going forward into this New Year of 5783. Those names remembered in this Booklet are helping us go forward in building a Jewish future for this community. The over 300 youngsters who pass through our doors every day and the 45 B'nai Mitzvah each year and those who start their married lives here are building their Jewish futures because we remember our past and what we need to do for the future.
