## A Yizkor Message

Tearing a piece of clothing or a ribbon is a well known and time honored tradition of mourning of our people. Already in the Bible we read that Jacob tore his garment when he believed that his son Joseph had died and David tears his clothes when he hears of the death of King Saul. For thousands of years after these events Jews have continued the practice of 'keriah' – tearing a garment or ribbon. The symbolism is quite clear: it represents our broken and 'torn' hearts and it also identifies to others that you are in mourning.

It is important to note that we put a tear into the garment, but we do not tear a piece off – the torn part of the garment always remains attached to the whole ribbon. As Rabbi David Stern points out; "The tear is real; there is no gainsaying the rupture we feel in our lives when someone we love has died. But the 'woven together' is real, too – their memory, their example, their influence and their love remain threaded through the fabric of who we are." Interestingly, the Talmud talks about reweaving of the mourner's garment which was very important to poor people who had very few garments to begin with. The Talmud goes so far as to prescribe which kind of stitches can be used. There is one stitch that is forbidden and that is the stitch of the skilled tailors of Alexandria, which was a stitch that makes the tear disappear altogether. In other words, the Talmud forbids us from sewing up the fabric so completely as to make it look as if there was never a tear there.

We come to Yizkor both torn and mended at the same time from our losses. We know that the tear can never be completely stitched. We are never completely whole again but we are healed. We have been repaired while still remembering our loved ones and while still inviting them to live in our hearts and in our minds. To deny the loss by using the perfect stitch to cover it up is not realistic and to deny that we can heal and be repaired after such heavy losses is also not real.

The late Elie Wiesel wrote of his first trip back to his home village of Sighet where almost no Jews were left: "I met a Jew, one of the rare survivors, and we walked through the cemetery of Sighet. "To be a Jew," I asked, 'What does it mean to you? Does it mean turning your heart into a cemetery? "No", my companion said. "The heart of a man is a sanctuary... To be a Jew is to fill the sanctuary with light, without betraying the cemetery?

At this Yizkor service we are here to find strength in what remains behind. We find strength in their legacy. We are here to look at the proverbial torn garment that is not mended but is still very visible as a small scar on our souls. But it is a scar that leaves us also with wonderful memories that sustain us and strengthen us as we go forward with life here on God's earth. May the memories of our loved ones continue to be a blessing for generations to come. Amen.






