Thank you for your interest in applying for the Joel Newman (ה"ר) Israel Scholarship. This fund* was created in loving memory of Joel Newman, with an endowment by the Newman & Blomberg families.

The scholarship will be awarded based on need and merit to a young adult from our Beth Torah community who would like to attend an approved Israel program.

Prior to applying for the Joel Newman (ה"ר) Israel Scholarship, please be advised of the following:

1. All applicants must be a member of Beth Torah.
2. All applicants must be between the age of 14-24 when the Israel program takes place.
3. Applications will be considered if the Israel Program is in the spirit of Beth Torah and the Conservative Movement as approved by our rabbis.
4. Programs must be a minimum of 2 weeks long.
5. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
6. Parents and applicant will be required to interview with the scholarship committee.
7. All applications with supporting documentation must be submitted prior to the February 1, 2026 deadline.
