



SHIRLEY SCHREIBER FAMILY CAMP SIMCHA POLICIES

Registration:

1. For Synagogue Members: A **non-refundable** registration and security fee of \$450 is required for each camper and must be submitted with the registration form.
2. For Non-Synagogue Members: A **non-refundable** registration and security fee of \$650 is required for each camper and must be submitted with the registration form.
3. All enrollments are subject to space availability.
4. All placement requests should be made on the registration form. We will attempt to accommodate one request per camper.
5. A 10% sibling discount is applied and deducted from the lower of the two (or more) camp fees.
6. Payment plans can be set up through May 15, 2026. Final payment of camp fees is due no later than May 15, 2026. If Camp Tuition is not paid in full by this date, a child's space cannot be guaranteed.
7. Any registrations received after May 15, 2026 requires payment in full.
8. All Health Forms must be submitted to the camp office and be current to begin camp.

Refund & Cancellation Policy:

1. The registration and security fee paid at the time of registration is **non-refundable**.
2. Any request to cancel this contract and receive a refund of camp fees paid to date **must** be made in writing on or before **May 16, 2026**. Camp fees paid are **non-refundable under any circumstance** after May 16, 2026, and any cancellation or refund requests made after May 16, 2026 will **not** be considered.
3. In addition to the foregoing, camp fees will not be refunded under any circumstances after the commencement of camp, including, but not limited to, illness, vacations, inclement weather, or if a camper is asked to leave camp for behavioral and/or disciplinary reasons.

4. Any cancellation request submitted on or before May 16, 2026, and any request for refund of camp fees (excluding the non-refundable registration and security fee) will be subject to a \$150 processing fee (the "Processing Fee"). The Processing Fee will be automatically deducted from camp fees paid to date. If the amount paid to date is insufficient to cover the Processing Fee, the remaining balance will be charged to the payment method provided by the camper's family at registration. By signing this contract, the camper's family authorizes this automatic charge. The camper's family will remain responsible for all financial obligations under this contract until the Processing Fee has been paid in full.

Accident Form/Medications:

1. All allergies must be clearly noted in the health section of the registration form.
2. The health history provided to the camp of my child is correct to the best of my knowledge, and the child that I have registered have permission to engage in all prescribed camp activities, except as noted by the examining physician and myself.
3. BTBRC/Camp Simcha does not assume responsibility for any injury. In case of medical emergency, BTBRC/Camp Simcha has permission to take my child to the physician or hospital to secure proper treatment. Parent/guardian assumes responsibility for all fees.

General Policies:

1. BTBRC/Camp Simcha is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
2. I grant BTBRC/Camp Simcha permission to use my child's photograph in promotional materials. I agree that neither my child, our assignees, nor myself will be entitled to compensation for such use.
3. I agree to pay the program fees in which my child is registered; including registration, camp tuition, security and safety, NSF fees and late fees. Where applicable. I understand that if my camp balance is not paid in full by May 15, 2026, I will forfeit my reserved space with Camp Simcha and all monies paid.
4. I hereby give permission for my child to participate in all camp activities, including PG movies.
5. My child and I are aware that rules are established both before and during the summer, which enable us to provide a safe and secure environment for all. Any rules not followed may result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from camp.
6. All campers over the age of 3 must be potty trained.
7. All parents MUST obtain an official Beth Torah ID to enter campus. If you have 2025/2026 Beth Torah ID from the school year a new ID will not be required for camp.

Food Policies:

1. All lunches and snacks served at camp are kosher.

2. We are a peanut and tree nut sensitive campus.
3. All snacks brought from home must be pareve, and peanut and tree nut free.
4. If celebrating a birthday, all goods brought onto campus must be kosher and adhere to that day's lunch.
