



Frequent Asked Questions

Q. What are the start and end times of the school day? Do you offer ½ day options?

A. Morning carpool begins at 8:10 am. Full Day afternoon carpool ends at 3:00 pm (Monday to Thursday) and Friday dismissal ends at 2:00 pm. Half Day carpool ends at 12:30 pm.

Q. Do you offer Early Care, After Care, and After School enrichment?

A. Yes, Early Care starts at 7:30 am. After Care dismissal ends at 6:00 pm (Monday to Thursday) and 5:00 pm on Fridays. We offer several after-school clubs, providing unique enrichment opportunities for our students (for more information go to <https://btbrc.org/after-school-clubs/>)

Q. Do you offer sibling discounts?

A. Yes. A \$250.00 sibling discount will be applied to tuition for all siblings.

Q. Do you offer payment plans?

A. Yes. Tuition can be paid monthly, in up to 10 installments. Payments must end by April of that academic year.

Q. What happens if a family registers and then decides to delay the start or cancel the enrollment?

A. Registration fees are non-refundable. This fee will be valid for the duration of the current school year. The registration fee does NOT roll over to the following academic year.

Q. What kind of scholarships do you offer?

A. We accept Step Up and ELC (Early Learning Coalition of Broward County).

Q. Do you provide Financial Assistance?

A. Yes. We outsource to FACTS, a service that reviews documents to award financial assistance. They create a custom application and collect financial data so we can make accurate award decisions based on financial needs. All documentation received is scanned upon receipt and then destroyed. A non-refundable application fee is due before your application is submitted. Based on the need and availability of funds, allocations will be distributed by the end of May, and families will be informed via email. For more information, please contact the Admissions Office.

Q. Does the school have a nurse?

A. Yes. We have a full-time nurse on-site.
